

PRIOR AUTHORIZATION

There are some medications that have to be authorized by a doctor before you can get them, because the medications are approved or effective only for some conditions.

REVIEWING MEDICATIONS

Our review committee of doctors and pharmacists meets often to review medications and coverage under pharmacy benefit plans. They also recommend prior authorization guidelines.

SAFE AND EFFECTIVE

When making recommendations, the review committee focuses on medication safety, effectiveness, and cost, including:

- U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved uses
- Medication instruction labels
- Accepted or published clinical recommendations

GETTING A SHORT-TERM SUPPLY

If you must take a medication that requires prior authorization right away, there are two options that may work for you. First, ask your doctor if a sample is available. Or, check with your pharmacy to request a short-term supply of five days or less - keep in mind you will be responsible for the full cost at that time. If the prior authorization request is approved, then your pharmacist can fill the rest of your prescription.

REQUESTING A PRIOR AUTHORIZATION

Physicians can start the prior authorization review process by visiting ProAct’s online portal at <https://proactrx.promptpa.com>. Once we receive a completed prior authorization request from the physician, our reviews are completed within 2-3 business days. We will then communicate with the provider, member, and/or pharmacy, depending on the decision of the review.

- All medications that are considered specialty will require a prior authorization, even if they are not included in the document below.
- In this drug list, brand-name medications are shown in UPPERCASE (for example, CLOBEX) and generic medications in lower case (for example, clobetasol).
